# SUSPENDED STUDENTS FROM THE GRADUATION LIST

1. **Matilda Owusu Ansah** and **Isaac Appau Plange** were part of students whose grades were altered by Dr. Noble Agyapong and are yet to be reverted to their original grades.

Matilda Owusu Ansah's original score for NEGOTIATIONS AND CONTRACTING IN PROCUREMENT AND SUPPLY course is 30% (12%+18%), grade F. The Altered score on 1/23/2023 is 60% (18%+42%). Riveting Matilda's score to the original score means she will get a Grade F and, thus cannot graduate.

Issac Appau Plange's original score for the PRINCIPLES OF MARKETING course is 36% (11%+25%) grade F. Altered score on 5/29/2023 is 56% (11%+45%) and his score for STRATEGIC MANAGEMENT course is 67% (23%+44%). The altered score on 5/19/2023 is 40% (23%+17%). Riveting Isaac's scores to the original score means he will get a Grade F in Principles of Marketing, and thus cannot graduate.

- 2. **Alex Blankson,** even though he has FCWA per the graduation list, the Faculty Board found the conduct of the examination that earned him the final year grades irregular which is subject to investigation of some senior members. Therefore, until the investigation is completed, and a determination made on the validity of the examination that resulted in Alex Blankson's grades he does not qualify to be part of the current graduation.
- 3. **Anna Sekyiwa** (040119185), pursuing a Management Degree under the KNUST programme, has accumulated 138 credit hours and had a grade of 'F' in Managerial Economics, rendering her ineligible for graduation. Her name was thus excluded from the attached list considered and submitted to the Examination Board by the Faculty Board.

#### *Note:*

Hafsa Salisu's *(page 12, S.N. 4)* original score for STRATEGIC MANAGEMENT is *51% (24%+27%)*. The altered score on 3/27/2023 is 77% (24%+53%). Riveting Hafsa's score to the original score means he will get 51%, and thus can graduate, but his transcript must be corrected to reflect the original grade.
