APPOINTMENT OF VICE-CHANCELLOR

The Governing Council of Ghana Communication Technology University, Tesano, announces a vacancy for the appointment of a VICE-CHANCELLOR of the University.

THE UNIVERSITY

The Ghana Communication Technology University (GCTU) is a technology-oriented institution of higher learning, established in November 2005 as the Ghana Telecom University College. It received accreditation from the National Accreditation Board (NAB) on 30th March, 2006 and was subsequently renamed Ghana Technology University College (GTUC). On 13th August, 2020 following the presidential assent to the Ghana Technology University College Bill passed by Parliament, the Institution attained the University status and was renamed Ghana Communication Technology University (GCTU) under Act 2020 (Act 1022).

THE POSITION

The Office of the Vice-Chancellor is a top-level Executive Position. He is the Executive Head of the University and is responsible, under the Council of the University, for both the Academic and Administrative functions. He is also responsible for the promotion of quality higher education and the provision of academic and administrative leadership. He is charged with the responsibility of initiating new directions in the academic development of the University and for implementing the University's Strategic Plan. The Vice-Chancellor is the Chief Disciplinary Officer of the University and exercises general disciplinary functions over both members of staff and students subject to the Statutes and Regulations of the University.

THE PERSON

- Must be a Full Professor
- Must be an internationally acclaimed and/or distinguished Scholar
- Must have a proven capacity to motivate, manage and direct Staff
- Must exhibit a high sense of industry, leadership qualities and organizational skills
- Must be circumspect and above reproach
- Must possess excellent communication and inter-personal skills and capacity to manage and control crisis situations
- Must be visionary, business-oriented and able to establish rapport between industry and the University for a common purpose
- Must be sober with maturity and drive for sound and impartial judgement
- Must have the capacity to raise funds and other resources for research and other development activities of the University
- Must be able to serve a full FOUR-YEAR Term of Office before attaining the compulsory retiring age of SIXTY (60).

TERMS OF APPOINTMENT

- The Position, which is full-time, shall be for FOUR (4) YEARS in the first instance and is eligible for reappointment for another term only.
- Salary and Conditions of Service attached to the position are very attractive.

- A Statement of Vision for the Ghana Communication Technology University, including strategies for achieving the Vision, in not more than five (5) pages of A4 size, typed in Times New Roman, font size 12, 1.5 line spacing, and with 2.54cm margins on all sides.
